**What to expect next**

You will receive separately an official acceptance letter from the Admissions Office. Please make note of your **KSU ID number** at the top of your acceptance letter. This is how KSU will identify you in its computer system, and you will need your ID number for class registration and other purposes. The letter also notes that you should submit an immunization form to KSU. A copy of the immunization form is enclosed. Completion of this form may require a visit to your healthcare provider. Mail or fax the completed form directly to the Registrar's Office, as noted on the form, *not* to the DEHP office.

In March 2019, all dual enrollment students will be required to attend a group advising session at KSU to select their courses for Fall semester and receive instructions for Accel and Move on When Ready funding applications. In advance of these sessions, by early March, you will receive an advising mailing from the DEHP office with instructions for registering for a session and important information to review before your advising session. Please do **not** apply for funding until after you have attended an advising session. After the advising session, you will visit your high school counselor for approval of your proposed schedule and funding application. You will register for Fall classes in late March.

In between now and then, we would like to communicate with you and your parents via email to provide updates and reminders. We will communicate with students **only through their new KSU email accounts** (see instructions below) – *not* your personal email address that you may have provided on your admissions application. Please complete and return the enclosed Advising Information form to give us parent email addresses and other important information about you.

**What to do next**

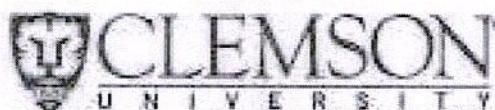
